Nancy Ryan Barnes RDH, BA is a member of the ADHA, IFDH, NYSFD, AADB, CDCA, and founding member of the AADH. She is currently the chair of the AADH Awards Committee and Chair of the Course Approval Committee that is charged with the review of the applications for approval of courses by national associations, corporate entities, state/component associations, academic institutions, AADH members and non-members. She has held several leadership positions for New York State Dental Hygienists' Association and was instrumental in securing legislation in New York for mandatory continuing education requirements and additional hygiene licensure related law changes. She has written articles for AADH Times, ADHA Access, Contemporary Dental Hygiene and two International dental hygiene

organizations in Germany and Israel. She has presented continuing education courses nationally and internationally and during the Symposium of International Federation of Dental Hygiene. Currently she is a member/examiner for the CDCA, formerly NERB, involved in the testing for licensing Dental Hygiene Candidates. Nancy retired from the position of AADH Executive Director in 2008 after over 12 years. The success of the American Academy of Dental Hygiene is a passion in her life.



Kyle Isaacs RDHEP, BHS is an expanded practice dental hygienist (EPDH) having worked in a variety of patient care settings in Oregon. She started a mobile dental hygiene business in 2014 taking care of low-income patients in a local church, long-term care facilities, schools, adult foster care homes, and private residences for patients who are not ambulatory. In 2017, she co-wrote a proposal for a pilot project to educate the staff at long-term care facilities and to provide preventive dental hygiene services and make referrals. She also worked in an integrative medical practice where she screened patients, applied fluoride varnish, oral health education and made referrals, as well as conferring with the medical providers there.

Kyle currently works for Benton County in Oregon where she writes a monthly oral health column for all county employees, and provides dental hygiene services for low-income patients as well as, at the pediatric clinic for low-income children and pregnant women. She teaches the oral health unit for people enrolled in certification as a community health worker.

She is a speaker and a published author in RDH Magazine. Kyle is a member of the AADH, ADHA, NNHH, DHHAPA, and ADHP. In 2018 she was a delegate to ADHA in Ohio. She's been a board member for the National Network of Healthcare Hygienists and in 2014 for the Oregon Dental Hygienists' Association (ODHA). Kyle was trustee for ODHA representing the state for Lane County and also as Southwest Director from 2015-2019. From 2016- 2019 she was on the conference committee. In 2017 she was the recipient of the Sunstar Award of Distinction and in 2018 she received the HuFriedy/ADHA Master Clinician Award. As an experienced dental hygienist, Kyle truly supports the mission of AADH.



Lisa Mallonee BSDH, MPH, RD, LD received a Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene and a Master of Public Health with a coordinated degree in nutrition from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Lisa is a tenured Professor, Graduate Program Director and Registered Dietitian in the Caruth School of Dental Hygiene at Texas A&M College of Dentistry, where she currently teaches courses in public/community health and provides nutrition lectures in the dental hygiene and predoctoral dental curriculum. Additionally, she oversees practicum placement and thesis research as a co-director for postgraduate dental hygienists enrolled in the Master of Science in Education for Healthcare Professionals program housed in the Texas

A&M College of Medicine. Furthermore, she serves as a preceptor for the Baylor University Medical Center Dietetic internship program. As a health care professional and educator, she is committed to two

interconnected goals: sharing her knowledge, expertise, and passion while promoting the value of interprofessional collaboration among dental professionals within the wider healthcare community. Lisa serves as a reviewer and expert content advisor on numerous publications that include: The Journal of the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics, Journal of the American Dental Association, the Journal of Dental Hygiene and organizations such as the National Diabetes Education Program, National Maternal & Child Oral Health Resource Center and the American Dental Educators Association (ADEA). Lisa is a published author in dental textbooks and peer reviewed journals on multiple topics pertaining to diet, nutrition and oral health and the practical application to whole body health for dietetic and dental professionals. She co-authored the Nutrition Curriculum for the revised 2015 edition of the ADEA Curriculum Guidelines for Allied Dental Education Programs. 

Remembering Jane Weiner:



The field of dental hygiene and AADH have lost a valuable member. Jane Wiener passed away at the end of 2020 and left a void that cannot be filled. She was an author, editor, teacher, speaker, and leader in the field. Her board review classes were famous and helped untold prospective colleagues. She was a friend and mentor to more dental hygienists than anyone can name and was recognized for this with the 2005 Philips Oral Health Care/RDH Magazine Mentor of the Year Award. This was only one of her many awards, but the one she was most proud of was the 2003 Dr. Esther M. Wilkins Distinguished Alumni Award. Jane and Esther were long time friends and Jane wrote a moving

tribute after Esther's passing. As accomplished as she was, Jane was the first to encourage, support, and congratulate others on their achievements. We were fortunate to have Jane as a colleague and a member of the American Academy of Dental Hygiene and she is dearly missed. May she rest in peace.

 - Present a continuing education course which meets AADH guidelines for course approval.
